Our Commitment

Ener-Vate is committed to achieving Net Zero emissions across all operations by 2050 at the latest, in line with UK statutory targets. Where possible, we will work to accelerate our target to align with regional decarbonisation strategies while helping our clients deliver low-carbon, sustainable heat network solutions.

Our Objectives

To deliver our commitment, we will:

- Establish a baseline of all Scope 1, 2 and 3 emissions within operational control.
- Collect reliable data and report our carbon footprint annually.
- For any residual emission we cannot reduce directly, we will utilise verified carbon offsets.

Our Actions

In our capacity as a specialist heat network consultancy, we offer a range of products — EVOLVE, CONNECT, DEVELOP, MANAGE and COMPLY — each designed to support a specific stage of the project lifecycle. Together, they provide a joined-up approach that helps navigate complexity, unlock low-carbon opportunities and deliver long-term value for our clients. Within our business we are already taking action to limit our impact on the environment by optimising remote and hybrid working solutions to reduce the unnecessary emission associated with business travel as well as providing a cycle to work scheme to support decarbonised employee commuting.

To reduce our emissions further, we will:

- Prioritise the use public transport or low-emission travel where business travel is necessary for the operation of our business.
- Maximise the efficiency of any energy-consuming equipment we own and manage.
- Apply the waste hierarchy and circular economy principles to our approach to waste management to reduce our Scope 3 emissions.
- Digitise our business to operate a paperless working environment.
- Embed sustainability considerations when selecting suppliers and encourage sustainable procurement actions throughout our value chain.
- Promote environmentally responsible behaviours across our workforce.
- Continue supporting clients in delivering decarbonisation and heat network optimisation through our consultancy services.

Monitoring and Review

Progress against our commitment and these actions will be reviewed annually by senior management. The plan will be updated periodically to reflect changes in legislation, best practice and our business operations.
